First, My place of residence is Buckley Press Co. Tacoma, Wash.
Second, My occupation is Printer
Third, I was born on the 23 day of April 1894 at Przemysl, Galicia, Austria
Fourth, I emigrated to the United States from Przemysl, Galicia, Austria on the 10 day of September 1910
Fifth, I declared my intention to become a citizen of the United States on the 10 day of September 1910
Sixth, I am married; My wife's name is Mary who was born on the 10 day of September 1894
Seventh, I have one child, and the name, day and place of birth, and place of residence of such child is as follows:
James Wash
Przemysl, Galicia, Austria
10 day of September 1910
Tacoma, Wash.

I am not a disbeliever in or opposed to organized government or a member of or affiliated with any organization or body of persons teaching disbelief in or opposed to organized government. I am not a polygamist nor a believer in the practice of polygamy. I am attached to the principles of the Constitution of the United States, and it is my intention to become a citizen of the United States and to renounce absolutely and forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty, and particularly to The Czechoslovak Republic of which at this time I am a subject, and it is my intention to reside permanently in the United States.

I speak the English language.

I have resided continuously in the United States of America for the term of five years at least immediately preceding the date of this petition, to wit, since the 10 day of September 1910 and in the State of Washington continuously next preceding the date of this petition, since the 10 day of September 1910 having a residence within this State of at least one year next preceding the date of this petition.

I have not heretofore made petition for citizenship to any court. (I made petition for citizenship to the U.S. Dist. Court of Western District of Wash. on the 10 day of September 1910 and the said petition was denied by the said Court for the following reason: was not a citizen of the United States.)

Attached hereto and made a part of this petition are my declaration of intention to become a citizen of the United States and the Certificate from the Department of Labor, together with my affidavit and the affidavits of the two subscribing witnesses thereto, required by law. Wherefore your petitioner prays that he may be admitted a citizen of the United States of America.
